i'll never forget the day i published this video i uploaded it at the Fandor office on Dec 13 2011 and then my boss took me to lunch to tell me that they decided the videos just weren't viral enough and that my services were no longer needed

i came back from the worst lunch of my life to a very excited office wondering why their website traffic was exploding

then my boss asked me out to a coffee

and offered to let me keep making videos

i agreed because i didn't have

other options to make a living doing this work

this question of how work is to be valued aesthetically commercially ideologically etc etc became more and more present for me.

but while i was having my love hate relationship with fandor

people in GERMANY expressed much more enthusiasm with less reservation starting with two Berliners named Michael Baute and Volker Pantenburg who invited me to the Kunst der Vermittlung program at the Arsenal in 2009

and they told me about a filmmaker i should pay attention to

named Harun Farocki and encouraged me to study his works i followed their advice and here is an example of one of my Farocki studies
